

## NEW BUILDINGS ON PEACHTREE,

Outside the City Limits, Make an Important Addition to Atlanta's Population.

A few Sunday's ago THE CONSTITUTION printed a list of the new buildings erected in Atlanta this year. The list covered the houses reported by the sanitary inspectors and was the fullest and nearest complete that could be had from any source. Here and there a house was overlooked, but very few escaped the attention of the inspectors.

Those outside the city limits were not included and it happens that some of the finest residences on Peachtree street are beyond that line and so did not come in the list that was published. Nevertheless they are really as much a part of Atlanta as any other houses, for they were built and occupied by people who do business in the city and have erected houses in its outer edge. The fact is that the legal city limits do not begin to cover the whole of the city. It has overflowed them in places since they were extended by the legislature two years ago.

Captain A. J. West furnishes the following list of houses built on the farther end of Peachtree this year:

F. M. Farley.....	\$40,000
Jack J. Spalding.....	10,000
Alex King.....	10,000
Mr. Crawford, on Bleckley avenue, near Peachtree.....	3,500
Mr. William G. Raoul.....	30,000
Mr. Hates, a banker from Griffin.....	15,000
Mrs. McGrath.....	3,000
Al J. West.....	14,000
