Attorney Hughes Spalding will build a \$40,000 residence on Peachtree road on a lot adjoining that of his father, Jack J. Spalding, just north of Brookwood. The house will occupy a lot having a 150-foot frontage.

Plans calling for a two-story brick house, trimmed with limestone and roofed with colored slate are being drawn by R. S. Pringle, architect.
